Shiryo kan [Museum]

This museum was established in October 1985 to hand down the history of Nagasaki Shipyard which played important role in Japan's industrial modernization.

The red brick building of the museum was built in 1898 as a wood-pattern shop attached to the foundry of Nagasaki Shipyard, Mitsubishi Goshi Kaisha and is the oldest building remaining here in the shipyard.

The building had been survived the danger of air raids and even the blast of the Atomic bomb during World War II, and yet, the red brick structure is growing even more beautiful with an eventful history spanning 100 years.

More than 900 collection of historic items are on display at 13 sections including photographs and actual articles that related to the history of technological progress in Japan.
